SNOW EMERGENCY

A snow emergency will be declared if it has been determined that the falling or accumulation of snow and ice upon Township streets constitutes a significant danger to the safety and well being of the residents and people traveling within the Township.

Emergency vehicles will announce the snow emergency throughout the neighborhoods by loudspeaker and the community access channel will carry updates throughout the day. The snow information number (610 734-7700) will be activated throughout the duration of the emergency.

Snow emergency routes have been designated by signs, which require those streets to be free of all parked vehicles twelve hours after the declaration of the emergency. Any vehicles that are not moved will be towed at the owner's expense.

RECYCLING ALERT

The Township is inaugurating the **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING** collection. **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING** is defined as the collection of newspapers & paper products; corrugated paper & cardboard; aluminum food & beverage cans; steel & bi-metallic food & beverage cans; plastic products numbered 1 or 2 (**no plastic bags**); and glass containers, excluded are plate glass, light bulbs, automotive glass, blue glass, porcelain and ceramic products.

In addition to the Single Stream collection, the Township is increasing the number of curbside **LEAF WASTE** collections. **LEAF WASTE** is defined in Pennsylvania ACT 101 as "leaves, garden residues, shrubbery and tree trimmings, and similar material, but not including grass clippings." (Trees must have a diameter of 4" or less.) The separate collection of **Christmas trees** is also included. **Do not use plastic bags** to recycle leaf waste. Place leaves in **biodegradable paper bags or loose in trash cans without bags**.

The Township of Upper Darby (UDT) has joined with the Delaware County Solid Waste Authority (DCSWA) in this effort of **LEAF WASTE** collection. Please note the following dates:

In addition to the above curbside collections, the DCSWA compost farm located at Transfer Station No. 1 on Concord Road in Chester Township will be open for residential and permitted commercial, institutional & municipal drop-off on the third Wednesday of each month, January thru September from 9 AM to 3 PM.

The Township is inaugurating the **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING** collection. **SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING** is defined as the collection of newspapers & paper products; corrugated paper & cardboard; aluminum food & beverage cans; steel & bi-metallic food & beverage cans; plastic products numbered 1 or 2 (***no plastic bags***); and glass containers, excluded are plate glass, light bulbs, automotive glass, blue glass, porcelain and ceramic products.

In addition to the Single Stream collection, the Township is increasing the times of curbside **LEAF WASTE** collections. **LEAF WASTE** is defined in Pennsylvania ACT 101 as "leaves, garden residues, shrubbery and tree trimmings, and similar material, but not including grass clippings." (Trees must have a diameter of 4" or less.) The separate collection of Christmas trees is also included. **Do not use plastic bags** to recycle leaf waste. Place leaves in **biodegradable paper bags or loose in trash cans without bags.**

SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING

Ordinance No. 2972 of Upper Darby Township Requires all residents to **separate** from their regular trash and to recycle the following:

1. NEWSPAPERS & PAPER PRODUCTS

Paper Products

- Newspapers, magazines and periodicals, catalogs, telephone directories, junk mail and paperback books. No plastic bags.
- Cardboard
- Cardboard, paper boxes, corrugated cardboard boxes, egg and cereal cartons, brown paper bags
- No waxed or plastic coated cardboard

2. ALUMINUM FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS

Acceptable

- Used beverage cans that are rinsed, clean and dry

Not acceptable

- Do not include foil, wrap, trays, plates, etc.

3. STEEL & BIMETALLIC FOOD & BEVERAGE CANS

Acceptable

- All steel and “bi-metal” household cans that a magnet will attract that are rinsed, clean and dry

Not Acceptable

- 55 gallon drums, paint cans, aerosol cans, gasoline and oil cans

4. PLASTIC PRODUCTS

Acceptable

- All plastic products numbered 1 or 2

Not Acceptable

- Plastic bags

5. GLASS CONTAINERS

Acceptable

- All glass containers

Not Acceptable

- Plate glass, light bulbs, automotive glass, blue glass, porcelain and ceramic products

AUTOMOTIVE FLUIDS – Oils, grease, coolant and other chemicals can seriously harm aquatic life when leaked through the ground or into storm inlets that drain to nearby creeks. Check and maintain your vehicle regularly. Service your vehicle on impervious surfaces so that leaks and spills do not soak through the ground. When servicing your vehicle, use drip pans to collect leaks and spills. Use an absorbent or rags to soak up leaks and spills and dispose of them properly. If leaks or spills are left on paved surfaces, the contaminants will be washed into the storm drains and into nearby creeks upon the next rainfall event.

PET WASTE – Pet waste can be a major source of bacteria and excess nutrients in local waters. When walking your pet, remember to pick up the waste and dispose of it properly. Flushing pet waste is the best disposal method. Leaving pet waste on the ground increases public health risks by allowing harmful bacteria and nutrients to wash into the storm drain and eventually into local water bodies.

POOL WATER DISCHARGE – Pool water containing Chlorine, even in low levels, when discharged directly into the storm drains or sewers can adversely impact the aquatic life within the creek. In addition, pool water should not be discharged onto paved streets that indirectly drain towards storm inlets and into the creeks. DEP guidelines suggest discharging pool water over pervious or grassy areas at a rate that allows for the water to infiltrate and aerate the ground so that erosion does not occur.

**SINGLE STREAM RECYCLING.
HOW YOU CAN MAKE A DIFFERENCE**

Newspaper and Paper Products

Newspapers are commonly recycled into paperboard, new newsprint, insulation and animal bedding products. Recycling newspaper also saves valuable space in landfills. Paper products are designed as telephone books, magazines, paperback books, junk mail and corrugated paper. Put the paper in paper bags or tie in a bundle.

Aluminum Food and Beverage Cans

For recycling purposes, aluminum is defined as all aluminum food and beverage cans. Aluminum cans are recycled to reduce litter, keeping roadsides, parks and playgrounds cleaner and nicer; and conserve energy, because producing new metal for cans from used aluminum cans saves 95% of the energy needed to produce aluminum from ore.

Aluminum can be recycled again and again, closing the loop between used and new cans. To make sure that a can is aluminum, take a regular magnet (available from hardware stores) and see that it does not stick to the can's top and sides. Rinse the cans to prevent attracting insects and crush the cans to save space.

Steel & Bimetallic Food and Beverage Cans

For recycling purposes, tin cans are defined as all steel and bimetal cans. Recycled steel is used to make new steel for manufacturing. A can is bimetallic if a magnet sticks to the sides. Rinse cans to prevent attracting insects and crush the can to save space.

Plastic Products

For recycling purposes, plastic products are defined as all plastic products numbered 1 or 2 (no plastic bags). Recycled plastic is used to make new plastic products and can be recycled again and again.

Glass Bottles and Jars

For recycling purposes, glass is defined as all clear, green and brown food and beverage containers only. See illustration of glass materials that are acceptable:

Leaf Waste

Anyone who has done yard work knows that leaves take up a lot of space. Leaves quickly reduce in volume by themselves if composted or allowed to degrade into rich mulch that is an excellent plant fertilizer. You can compost in your own back yard.

THE NEW BLUE RECYCLING CONTAINER PROVIDED BY THE TOWNSHIP IS TO BE USED ONLY FOR RECYCLING. ADDITIONAL CONTAINERS CAN BE OBTAINED FROM THE TOWNSHIP AT A COST OF \$10.00 EACH. IN ADDITION, ANY TYPE OF CONTAINER COULD BE USED FOR RECYCLING PROVIDED THAT THE CONTAINER IS CLEARLY MARKED "RECYCLING". A STICKER WITH THE TOWNSHIP RECYCLING LABEL WILL BE PROVIDED UPON REQUEST.
