Progress the jurisdiction has made in carrying out its strategic plan and its action plan. 91.520(a)

This could be an overview that includes major initiatives and highlights that were proposed and executed throughout the program year.

The Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, requires the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program to prepare and submit a Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER) to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) at the close of each program year. Upper Darby Township is an entitlement community for the CDBG program as designated by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and receives an annual allocation of CDBG funding. Upper Darby Township did not receive Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds in 2024; however, expenditures were incurred on the Township's 2023 ESG award. The CAPER provides the Township and interested stakeholders the opportunity to evaluate the progress in carrying out priorities and objectives contained in the Township's five-year plan.

The progress described in this report illustrates Upper Darby Township's efforts to utilize CDBG and ESG funding and enhance coordination with Community Development programs to create a more vibrant and livable community and improve the quality of life for low-income citizens in the Township of Upper Darby. Our team continued to prioritize the needs of the community while utilizing CDBG funds to forward the Township's Strategic Plan goals and objectives.

This is the fourth report for the five-year Consolidated Plan period, which began October 1, 2021 and continues through September 30, 2026. For PY 2024 (October 1, 2024 to September 30, 2025), Upper Darby Township undertook a variety of activities funded by CDBG in the areas of:

- Public Services to low- and moderate-income persons and families by funding the following human services agencies: CAADC/Cobbs Creek Housing Services for homeless assistance, Murphy's Giving Market for those experiencing food insecurity, The Domestic Abuse Project, and the Foundation for Delaware County.
- Affordable Housing: Provide Housing Rehabilitation to improve the condition of low/moderate income owner-occupied homes.
 Rehabilitation of fifteen households was anticipated. The Township completed 1 single-family rehabilitation project in 2024. The Township also funded a First Time Homebuyer Assistance program through the Affordable Housing Centers of PA and 2 households received assistance. The Township is in the process of soliciting new entities to administer both the housing rehabilitation and first time homebuyer programs and expects increased accomplishments during the next reporting period.
- Public Facilities & Improvements included the Golf Road Playground improvements, Guilford Road Sanitary Sewer Line improvements, Collenbrooks Farm Historic Preservation, and the Golf Road Parking improvements.

Additionally, the Township continued to implement activities from 2023 ESG funding, which included the Student Run Emergency Housing Unit of Philadelphia. Activities undertaken include emergency shelter, rapid rehousing and homeless prevention. A total of 166 clients were served with ESG funding in 2024.

Upper Darby Township exceeded its five year goals for Code Enforcement, Fair Housing, homeless assistance and public services. The Township far exceeded its annual and five-year goals for public facility improvements. While the Township fell short of it's annual housing rehabilitation goal, it far exceeded the five year goal for units rehabilitated. Upper Darby Township updated its program guidelines and issued an RFP for a new entity to administer the housing rehabilitation program. It is expected that the accomplishments reported for housing rehabilitation will increase in program year 2025 (Year 51).

Of those served in 2024, 49.44% were White and 46.60% were Black or African American. The overall population of the Township of Upper Darby consists of 63.3% White and 21.7% Black according to 2023 ACS 5-Year Estimates.

Narrative

Many of the activities undertaken in 2024 were public services and public facilities & improvements which served low-income households, townshipwide. Of all activities funded in 2024, 4,992 individuals were extremely low-income, and 167 individuals were low-and moderate-income.

ESG Expenditures

A total of \$128,022.52 ESG 2023 dollars were expended during Program Year 50. Student Run Emergency Housing Unit of Philadelphia provided shelter, rapid rehousing and homeless prevention services to 166 clients. Of the 166 clients served, 64 or 38.6% were white, 84, or 50.6% were black, 7 or 4.2% were Hispanic, 1 or .6% was Asian, and 1 or .6% was American Indian, Alaska Native, or Indigenous.

Leveraging

Federal funds have played a crucial role in leveraging additional resources in Upper Darby Township, through various programs and initiatives aimed at boosting local development and addressing community needs. Federal funds have supported strategic planning efforts, which, in turn, makes the township more attractive to additional funders and investors who are interested in building on these planning efforts.

CDBG funds do not require a match. SREHUP provided the ESG required dollar for dollar match through funds received from Delaware County, donations and community foundations.

Upper Darby Township did not meet the Affordable Housing Objective but did rehabilitate 1 housing unit and provided down payment assistance to two households. The Township updated the program guidelines for both programs and issued an RFP for a provider to implement the programs. It is expected that accomplishments for both will increase during Program Year 51. The number of homeless households reported as a one-year goal is households assisted by ESG. Those households are not reported in the Actual column.

By working towards meeting the affordable housing objective we have addressed a critical need, ensuring that more families have access to safe and affordable homes. Upper Darby Township will continue to allocate funding for housing rehabilitation in order to meet the Affordable Housing Objective in future program years.

Narrative Information

Upper Darby Township received CDBG funding only in program year 2024 and was not an ESG or HOME program recipient. Of the housing activities funded in 2024, 1 was moderate-income.

Reaching out to homeless persons (especially unsheltered persons) and assessing their individual needs

Upper Darby Township and its subrecipients participate in the Delaware County Continuum of Care (CoC). Each January, the CoC conducts a Point-in-Time (PIT) count of the sheltered and unsheltered homeless population to ascertain the number and characteristics of the homeless population and to assess their needs. The CoC reaches out to homeless persons (especially unsheltered person) through outreach teams, soup kitchens, day programs, drop-in centers, and hospitals. CoC Outreach teams work to engage the individuals who are least likely to engage in services through cultivating a connection utilizing food, care packages, including hygiene products and toiletries. The Outreach Team has a determined circulation throughout Delaware County where unhoused persons are known to congregate.

Addressing the emergency shelter and transitional housing needs of homeless persons

Community Action Agency CAADC/Cobbs Creek Housing Services to operate the Eastern Delaware County Life Center Homeless Shelter which is located within Upper Darby Township. Services provided include emergency housing, intensive case management, and supportive services to help individuals attain self-sufficiency and find permanent housing. This project substantially contributes to the Homeless Assistance need identified in the Consolidated Plan. During 2024, CCHS assisted 307 extremely low individuals at its shelter.

The Domestic Abuse Project is a Domestic Violence Advocacy program and provides services to victims of domestic abuse in a satellite office located in Upper Darby Township. Services include but are not limited to emergency shelter, a 24-hour hotline, legal services, attendance at court hearings, short- and long-term counseling, and assistance with finding permanent housing. During 2024, DAP served 150 individuals.

Upper Darby Township utilized its 2023 ESG funds to provide operating support for the Breaking Bread shelter during 2024.

Helping low-income individuals and families avoid becoming homeless, especially extremely low-income individuals and families and those who are: likely to become homeless after being discharged from publicly funded institutions and systems of care (such as health care facilities, mental health facilities, foster care and other youth facilities, and corrections programs and institutions); and, receiving assistance from public or private agencies that address housing, health, social services, employment, education, or youth needs

These services are provided mostly at the County level and by other non-profit organizations. SREHUP utilizes Upper Darby ESG funds to provide homeless prevention and stabilization services. Murphy's Giving Market, supported by Upper Darby CDBG funds, provides food security to households who may otherwise be at risk for experiencing homelessness. Providing food security allows households to focus their resources on maintaining housing stability.

The Foundation for Delaware County's Housing Opportunities Program for Equity (HOPE) helps low-income women and families with young children maintain safe, affordable housing through case management, civil legal aid, financial literacy and direct assistance.

The Welcome Center provides Fair Housing education for the community and also assists with Tenant Landlord disputes, especially for those that are immigrants and/or non-English speaking.

Helping homeless persons (especially chronically homeless individuals and families, families with children, veterans and their families, and unaccompanied youth) make the transition to permanent housing and independent living, including shortening the period of time that individuals and families experience homelessness, facilitating access for homeless individuals and families to affordable housing units, and preventing individuals and families who were recently homeless from becoming homeless again

Upper Darby Township supports the efforts of the Continuum of Care to address homelessness issues through their funded organizations. The CoC is responsible for quickly rehousing homeless individuals and families while minimizing trauma and dislocation. The program promotes access to and utilization of mainstream programs by homeless individuals and families and optimizes self-sufficiency among individuals and families experiencing homelessness.

The CoC has relationships with two PHAs in the region who provide move on and local preference strategies for households exiting homelessness to receive permanent housing through the PHA programs. SREHUP utilizes Upper Darby Township ESG dollars to provide rapid rehousing services that are designed to quickly place households from the shelter into permanent housing.

Actions taken to address the needs of public housing

The Delaware County Housing Authority provides Housing Choice Vouchers and owns and operates the Public Housing within Delaware County. Upper Darby Township did not use CDBG funds to support PHA needs during 2024.

Actions taken to encourage public housing residents to become more involved in management and participate in homeownership

This is done by the Delaware County Housing Authority.

Actions taken to provide assistance to troubled PHAs

The Delaware County Housing Authority is not a troubled PHA.

Upper Darby Township continues to review and update as needed the public policies and zoning to ensure they are not creating a barrier to affordable housing.

Actions taken to address obstacles to meeting underserved needs. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

Upper Darby Township recognizes that the greatest obstacle to meeting underserved needs is a lack of or inadequate resources; both human and financial. The Township continues to work with agencies to build support and advocacy for those populations and areas that are underserved and continues to try to identify and obtain resources to address their needs. County organizations provide aid to families in need through monthly case conferencing, health fairs, resource fairs, and other avenues. During 2024, Upper Darby Township continued to support public service organizations that provide housing, shelter, food security and housing counseling.

Actions taken to reduce lead-based paint hazards. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

All homes for rehabilitation are inspected for lead-based paint hazards by a third party. Information is provided to contractors by the Permits Office about their responsibility to inform customers about lead-based paint hazards. Remediation is completed as needed and a post remediation clearance is completed. Educational information is also provided to all Homeowners.

All participants in the Upper Darby First Time Homebuyer Program are required to have a visual lead inspection performed on the home to be purchased.

Actions taken to reduce the number of poverty-level families. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

Community Action Agency CAADC/Cobbs Creek Housing Services operates the Eastern Delaware County Life Center Homeless Shelter which is located within Upper Darby Township. Services provided include emergency housing, intensive case management, and supportive services to help individuals attain self-sufficiency and find permanent housing.

Programs such as the housing rehabilitation program have allowed homeowners to build and maintain equity in their homes. Social services are provided at the County level. Upper Darby continues to support local businesses to help create local jobs.

Actions taken to develop institutional structure. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

Upper DarbyTownship's housing and community development plan is carried out through a combination of public, private and non-profit organizations. To this end, the Township has continued to identify and overcome gaps in institutional structure by developing and enhancing partnerships with public sector

and private sector entities and non-profit organizations to address housing and community development needs. The Township continues to engage in additional communication and outreach to area housing and service providers to assist, when possible, with building and strengthening institutional delivery.

Actions taken to enhance coordination between public and private housing and social service agencies. 91.220(k); 91.320(j)

The Township remains committed to coordinating planning activities with private housing and social service agencies, including the Continuum of Care. The Township staff also continued its participation in other coalitions and study groups, when invited.

Upper Darby Township is in communication with the Delaware County Office of Housing & Community Development, Delaware County Housing Authority, CAADC, Continuum of Care, COSA, HOPE and the Delaware County Housing Working Group as well as other social service providers on a regular basis.

Upper Darby Township participates remotely in the bi-monthly educational seminars presented by the Housing Equality Center. The Township distributed fair housing materials and information about services that are available through their housing rehabilitation and First Time Homebuyer Program. The information obtained at the Housing Equality Center is shared with Township departments in order to educate them in their dealings in the community.

The Township also distributed Fair Housing posters and pamphlets throughout the community, including the public libraries and in all Township buildings, including the Welcome Center.

The CAADC with the public services funding provided for homeless assistance also provided housing counseling, credit counseling and housing placement services.

The Multicultural Center with their public services funding provided education to immigrant residents with English as a second language.

Upper Darby Township utilizes CDBG funds to support subrecipient efforts to host renter's rights forums to enhance fair housing education in th Township.

The Township of Upper Darby Department of Community and Economic Development monitors CDBG activities a minimum of once per year. A monitoring form is used to detail information regarding the number of files reviewed, the number of files in compliance, if any procured materials were identified and properly procured, along with a summary of conclusions and findings, if any. The Township's Finance Department also monitors the financial records to ensure the subrecipient complies with all CDBG accounting and financial regulations. The accountant has a separate financial monitoring system to use as an evaluation tool.

Performance reports are made readily accessible through the Township's website, where residents can view detailed information about various programs and services. Upper Darby actively encourages local Non-Profit Organizations within the Township to apply for Public Services funding and assists them with the submission of their applications and in meeting their stated goals.

The 15% Public Services cap limits the amount of funding that can be provided.

Goals and objectives have not been changed, but have been prioritized due to the limits of the funding. During Program year 51, Upper Darby Township will be conducting outreach to assist with the preparation of its 2026-2030 Consolidated Plan. This outreach effort will identify goals and objectives to direct the Township's CDBG, HOME and ESG programs for the five year period.
