**Request for CDBG Public Services Proposals**

Upper Darby Township is inviting nonprofit organizations to submit applications for Public Services project funding to be included in the CDBG Action Plan for Program Year 52.

The Township receives an annual entitlement of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funding through the United States Department of Housing & Urban Development for use in support of community development activities. No more than 15% of that annual entitlement grant may be used in support of Eligible Activities within the category of Public Services.

Upper Darby Township will prioritize projects consisting of eligible activities that directly contribute to Housing and related Quality of Life needs. Such services may include the activities that contribute to the acquisition of housing by low-and moderate-income persons, the prevention of homelessness, or the provision of shelter for those experiencing homelessness. Final project selection will be further informed by the priorities currently being identified in the 2026-2030 Five Year Consolidated Plan process.
