



Averages Per Platoon





Ethylene Oxide is a chemical utilized in the medical equipment sterilization process at medical facilities including the new CHOP building on Market Street.

Wood Frame Construction Legacy vs Lightweight Building Construction Class



Members of the Department attended a course on how to identify wood frame construction and light weight building construction sites. Lightweight construction is generally considered to be either wood frame or steel building materials, where the roof and/or floor supporting systems are constructed of lightweight prefabricated materials. The members learn how to handle the hazards of these buildings during emergencies.


Hazardous Materials Operations Refresher



Members in the department have completed their annual Hazardous Materials Operations Refresher. Every year after the initial training requirement has been met, workers are required to take an 8-hour HAZWOPER refresher course. This refresher course is designed to meet the annual training requirement for hazardous waste operations and emergency response (HAZWOPER) workers.

Members of the Department have completed their annual CPR/AED certification renewal.






Smoke Alarm Installations






