



### JUNE 2022 AVERAGE RESPONSE TIME



INCIDENT RESPONSES BY STATION








# JUNE 2022 INCIDENTS BY DAY OF THE WEEK






# JUNE 2022 INCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY








### JUNE 2022: FIRE PREVENTION EVENTS






