JULY 2022 AVERAGE RESPONSE TIME















INCIDENT RESPONSES BY STATION




INCIDENTS BY SHIFT




INCIDENTS BY DAY OF THE WEEK




JULY 2022 INCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY










