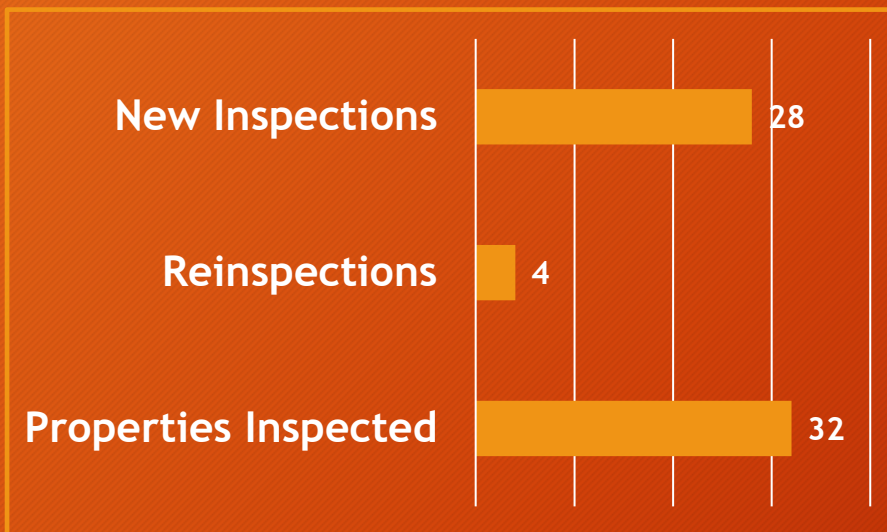

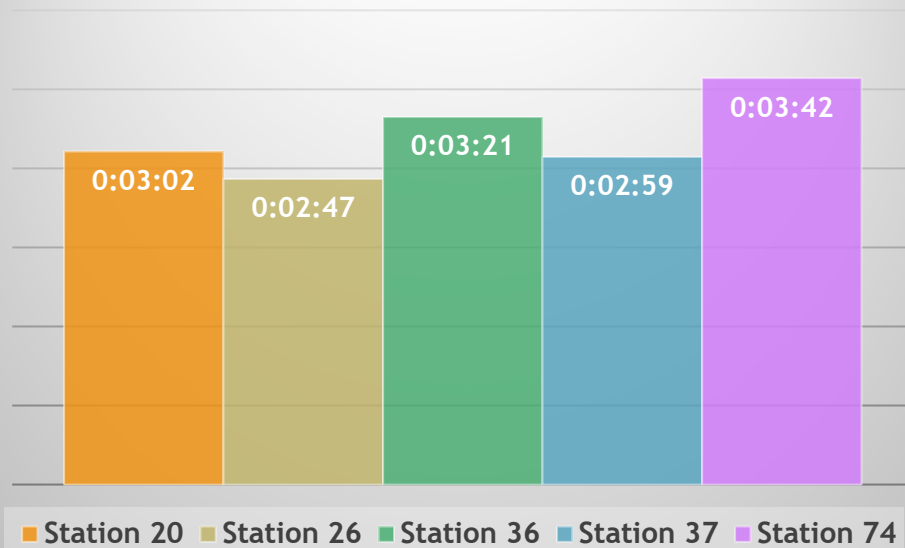

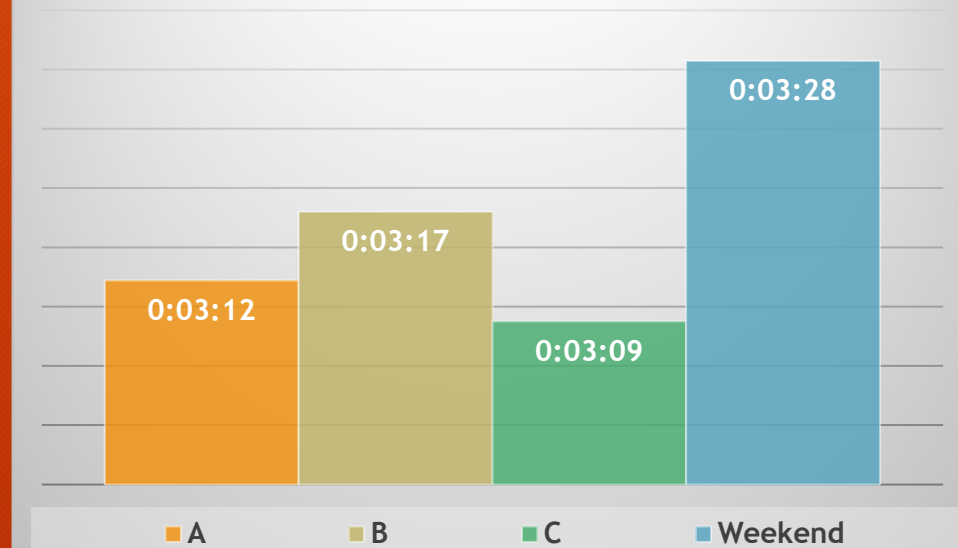
Average Response Time May 2023



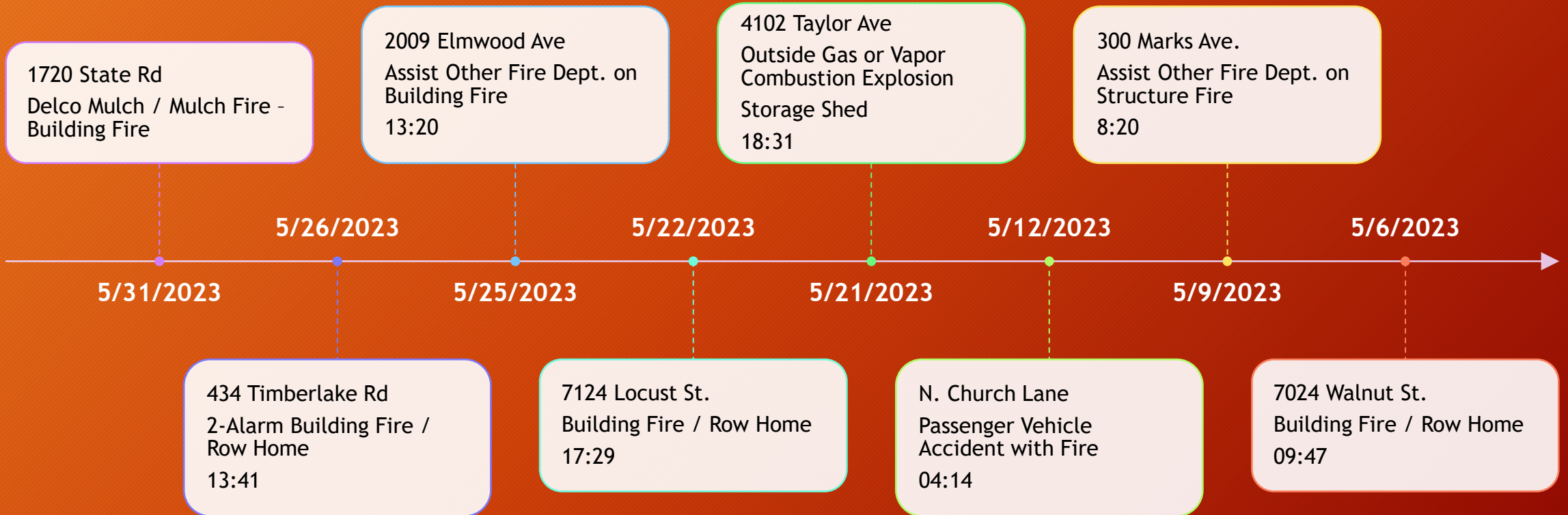
Averages Per Station



Averages Per Platoon



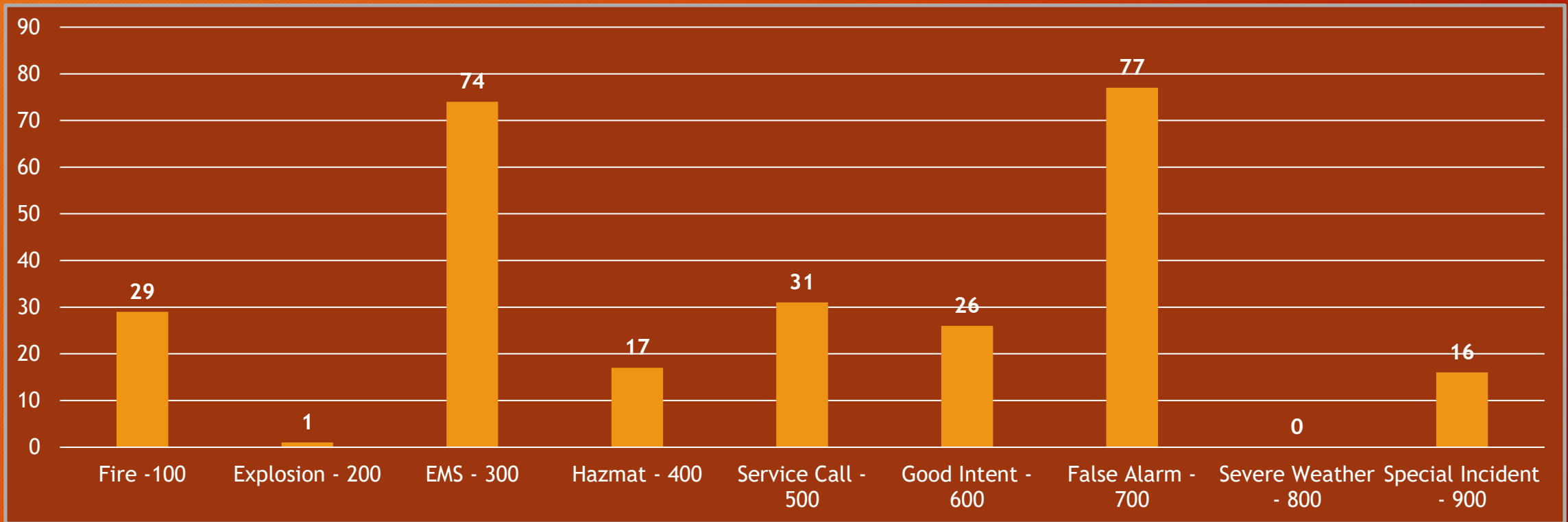

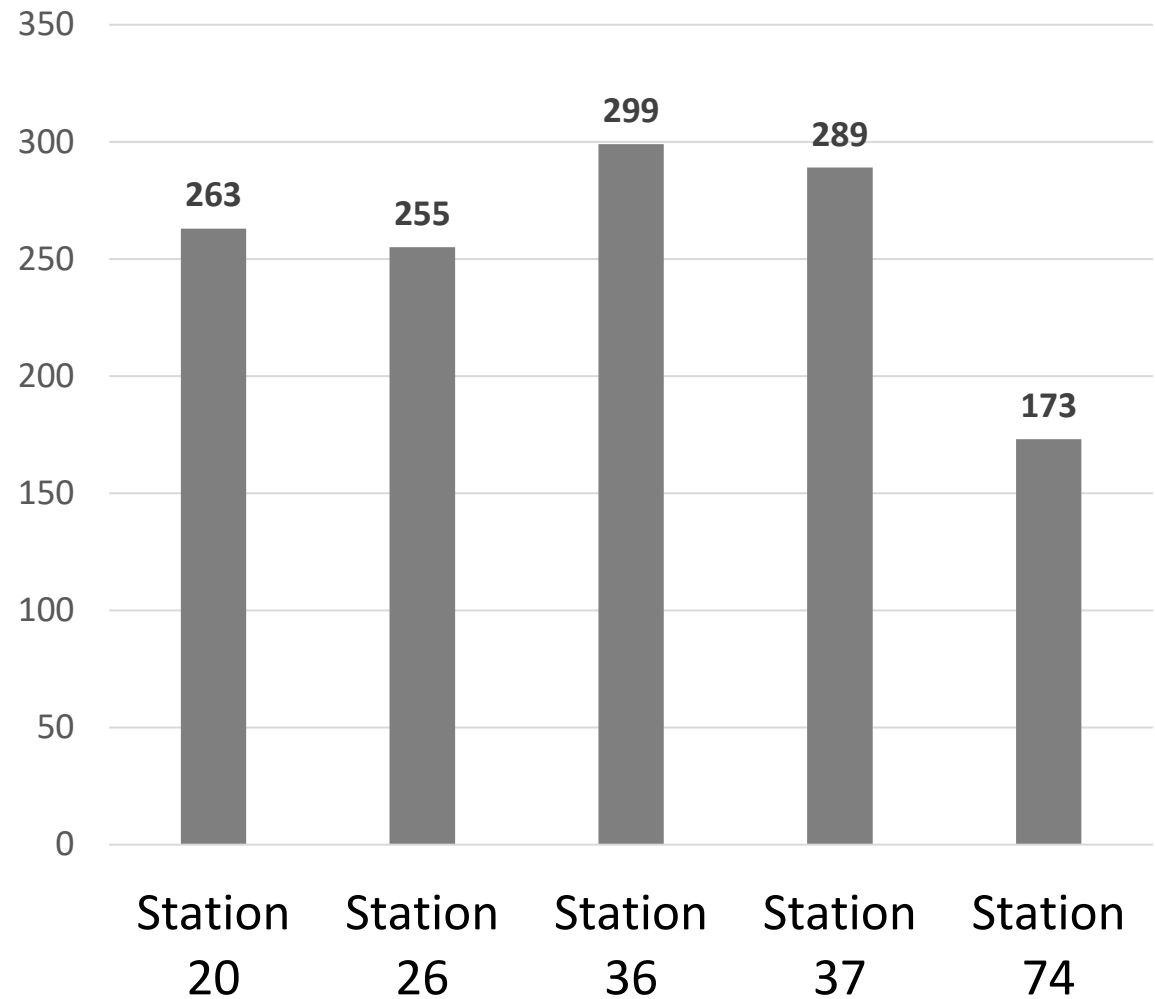

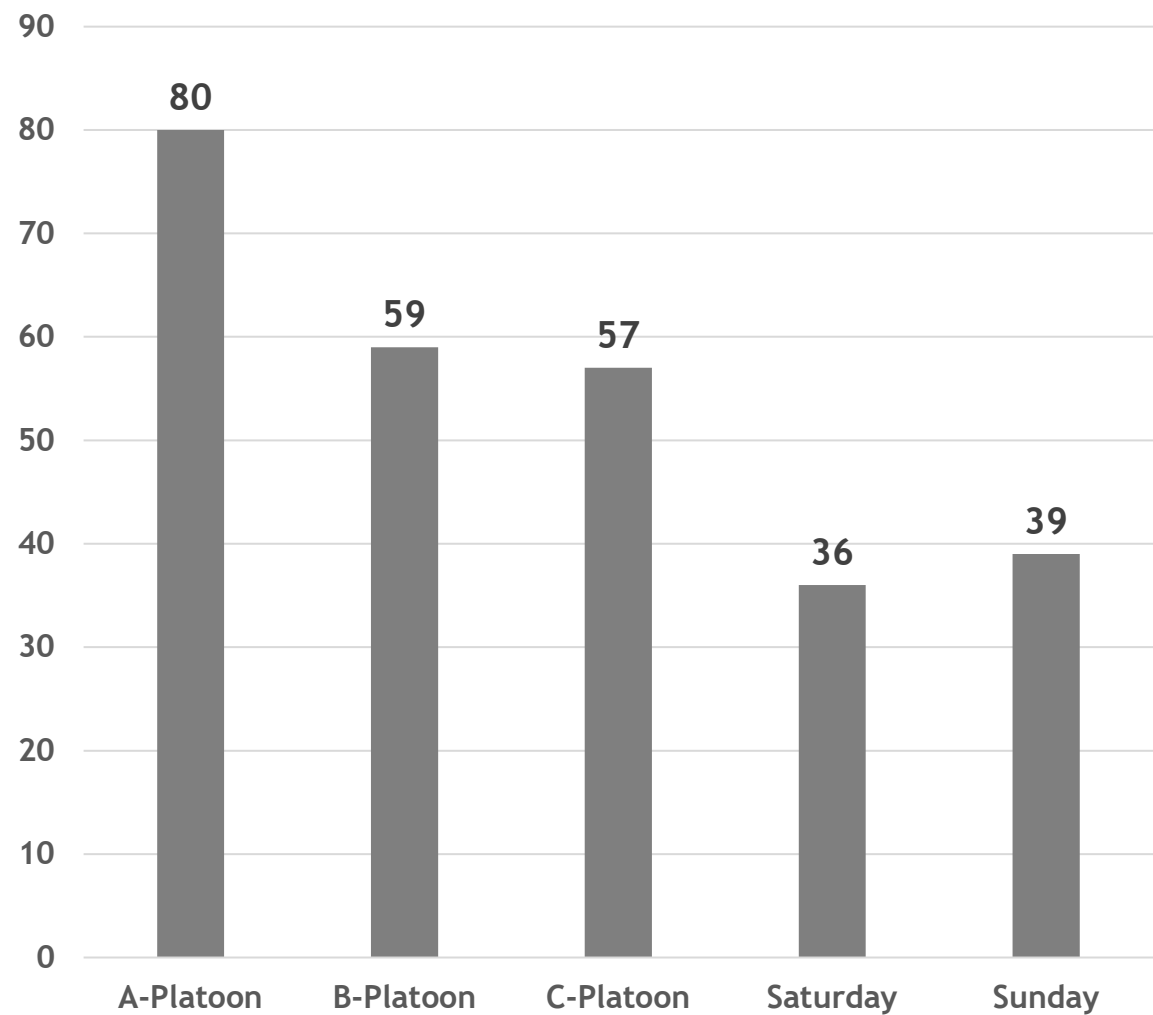

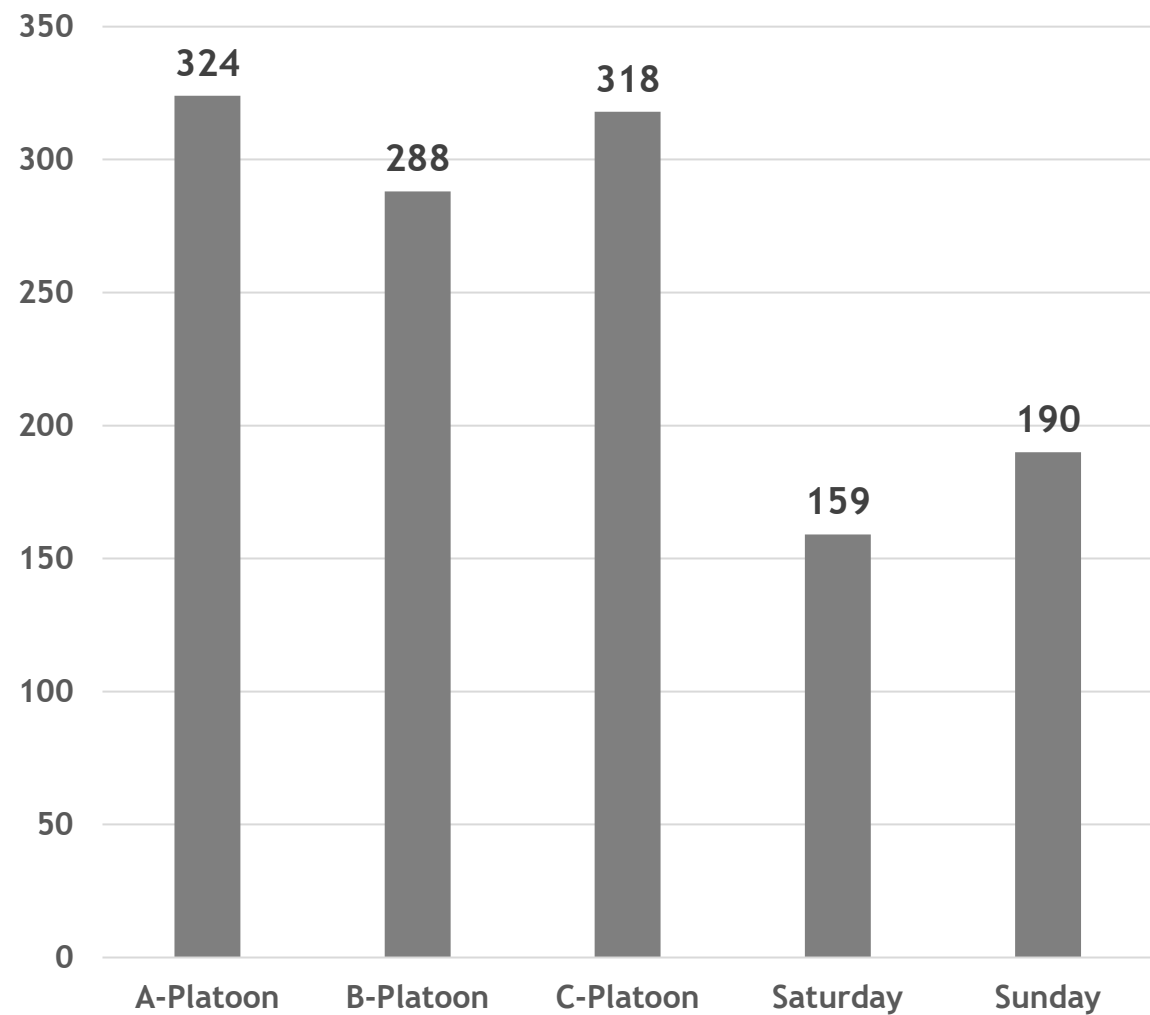

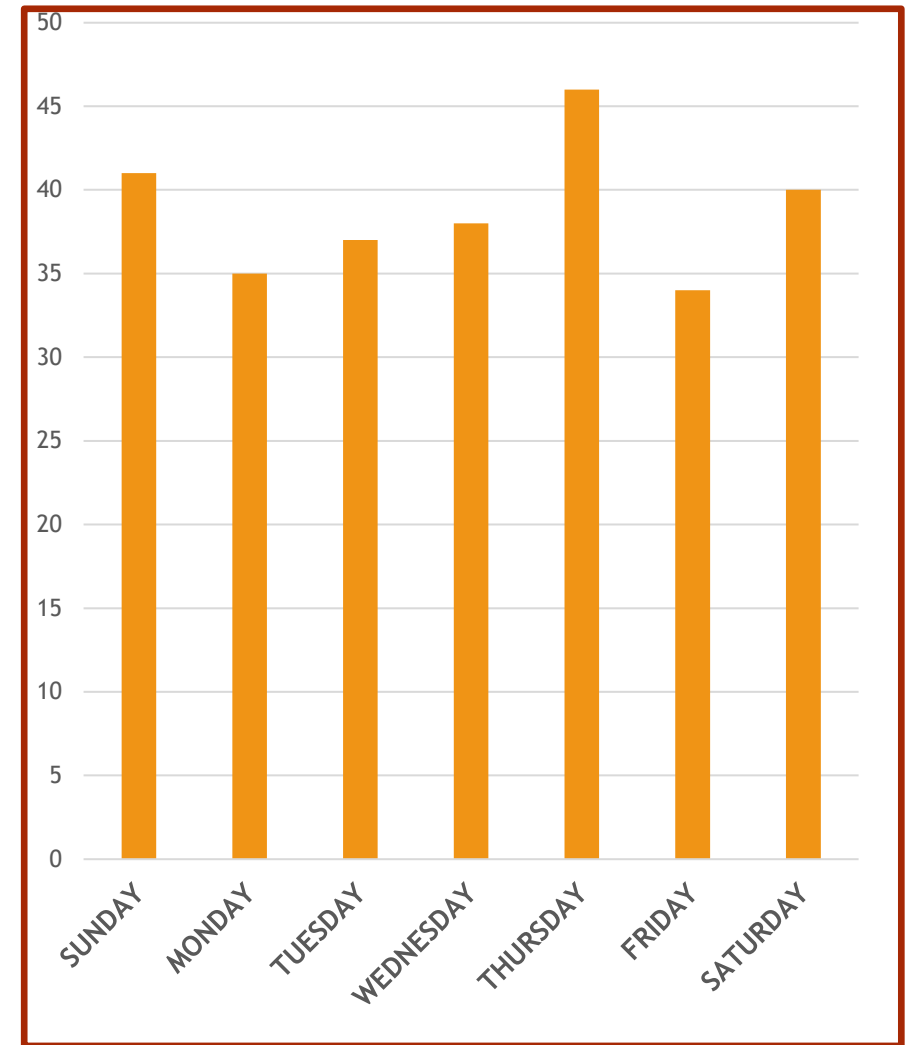

Incidents by Day of the Week

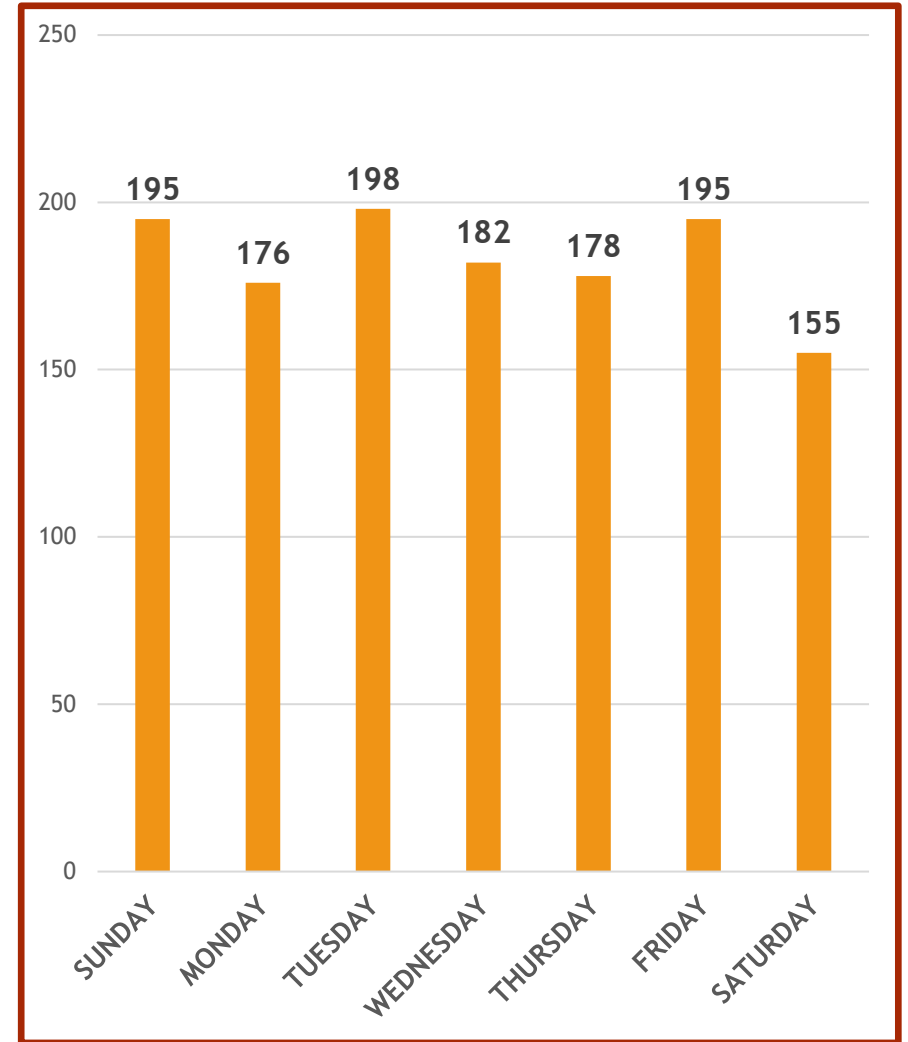

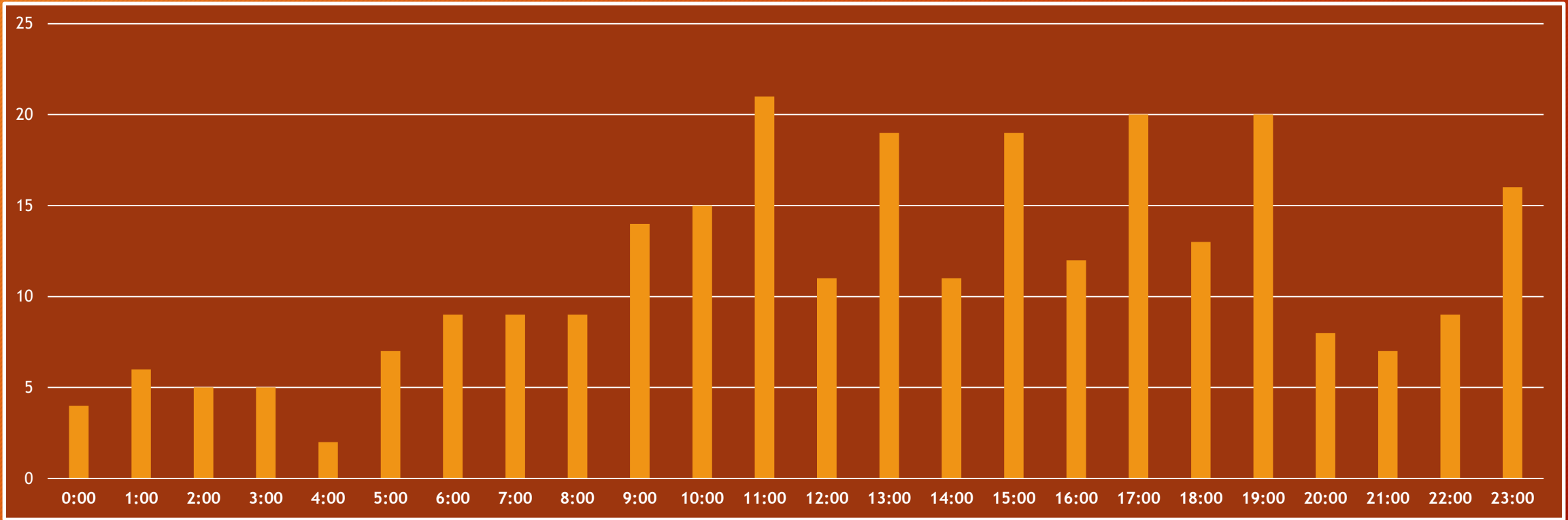

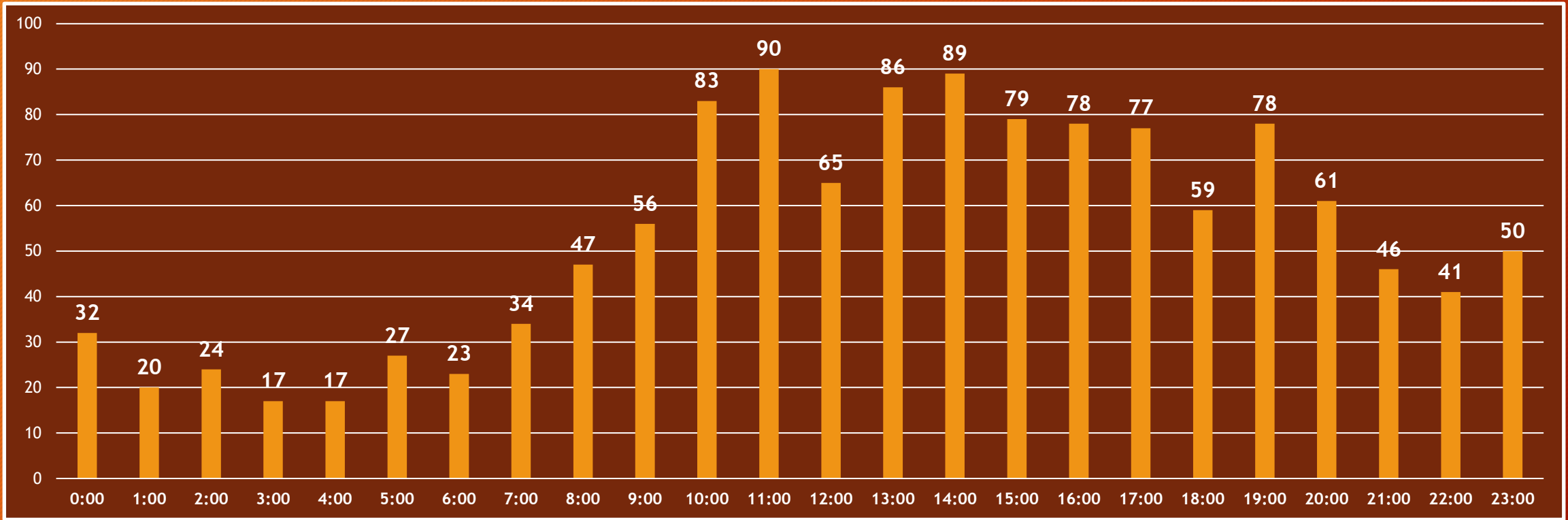




Incidents by Hour of the Day

2023 Year-to-Date Incidents by Hour of the Day

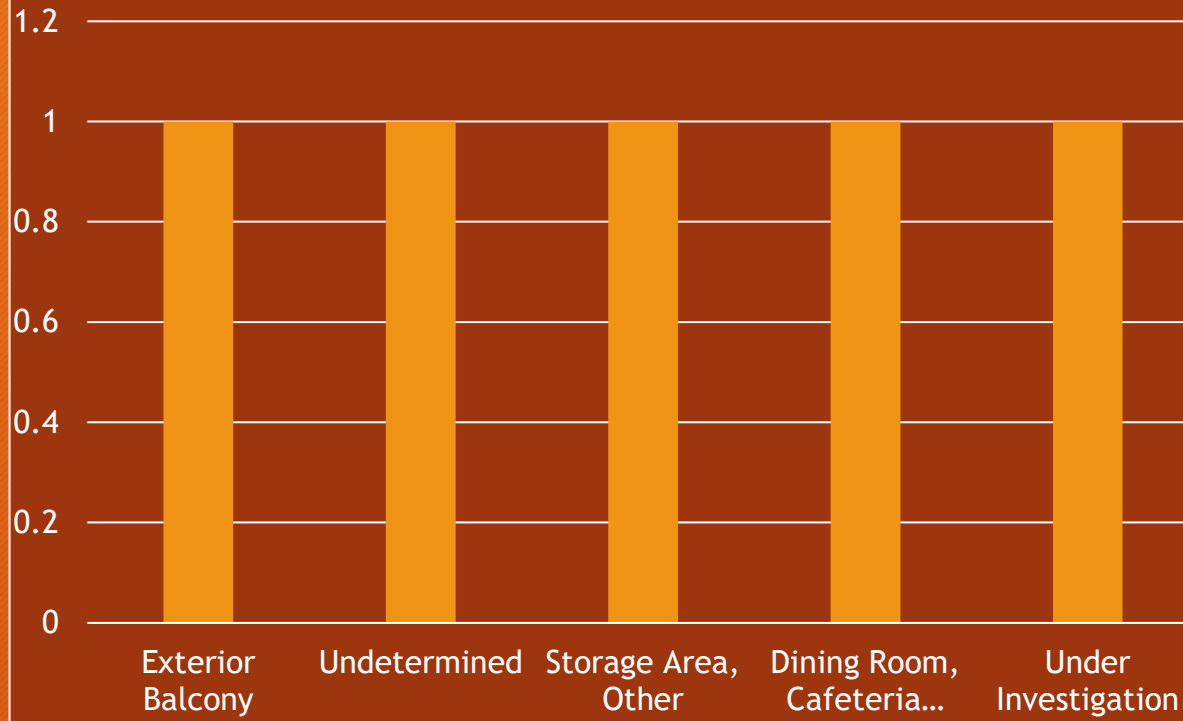

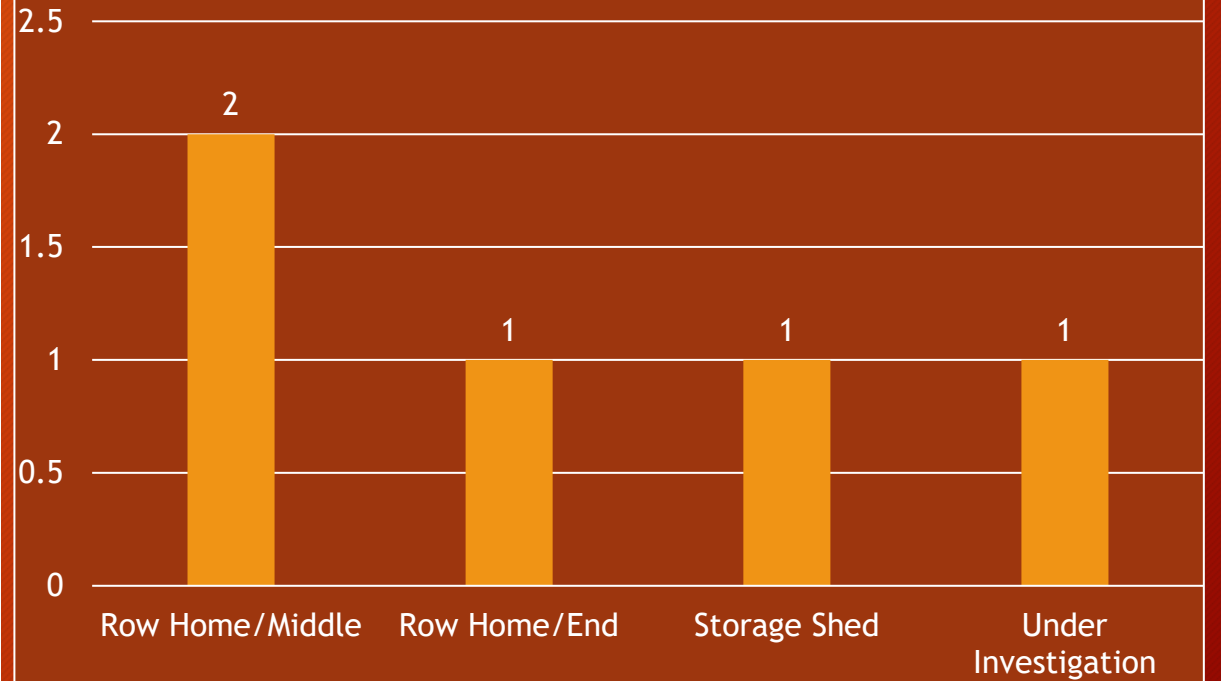

Property Use

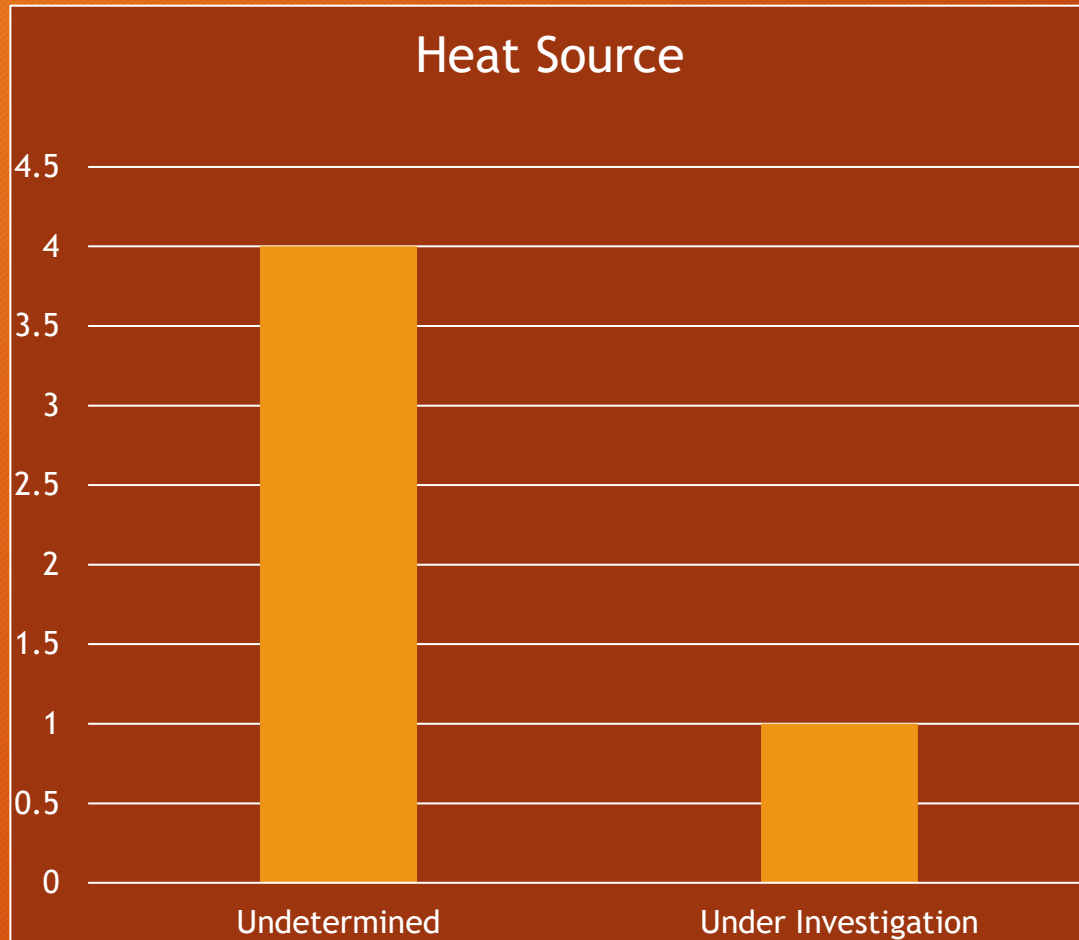

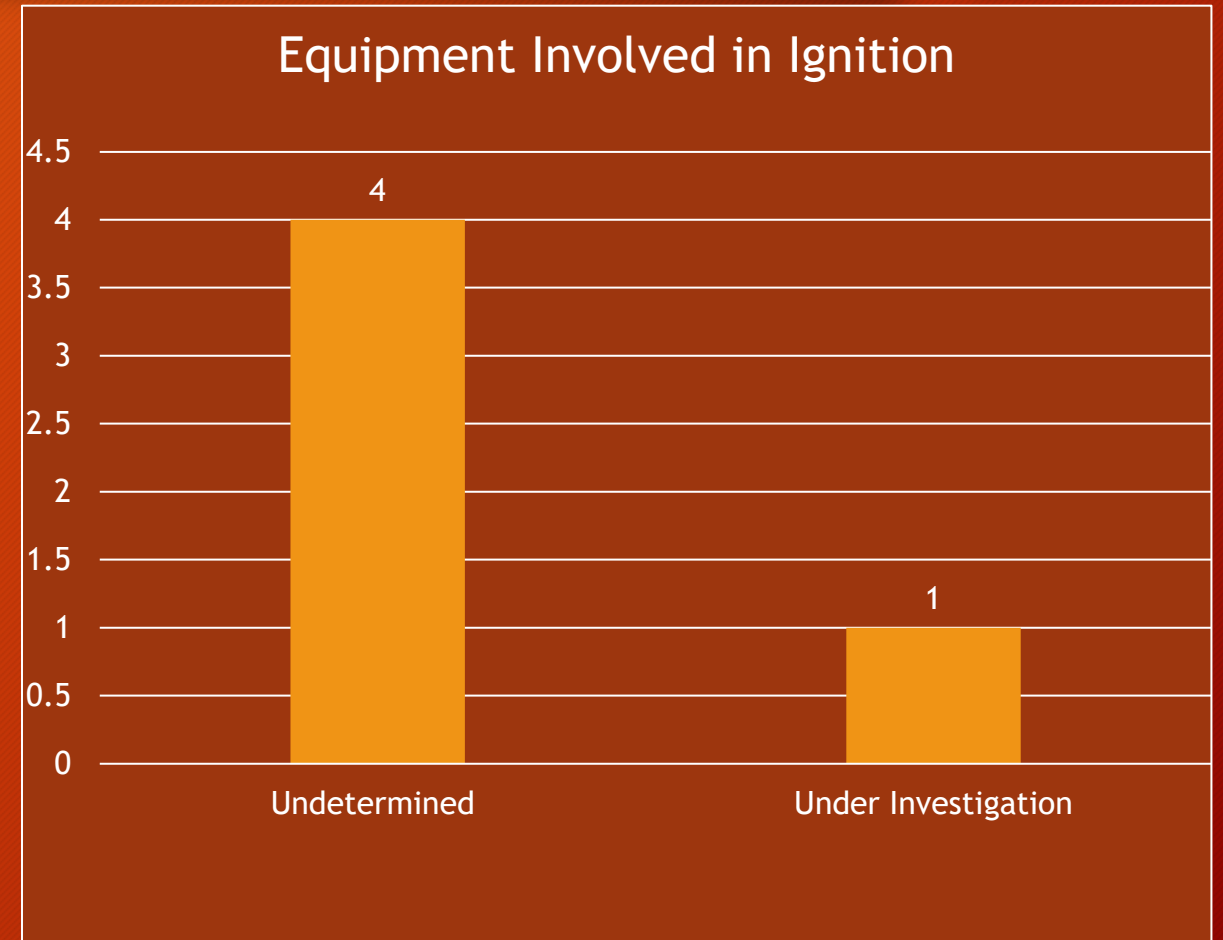

Equipment Involved in Ignition

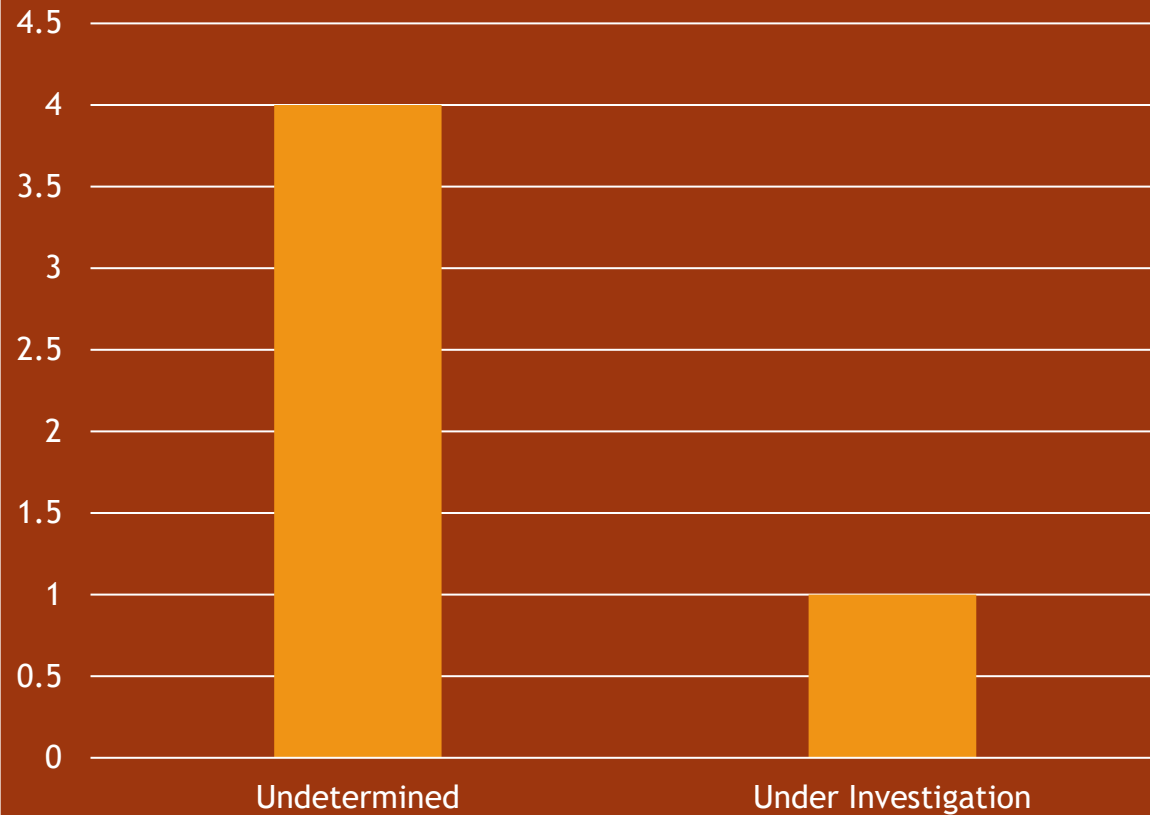

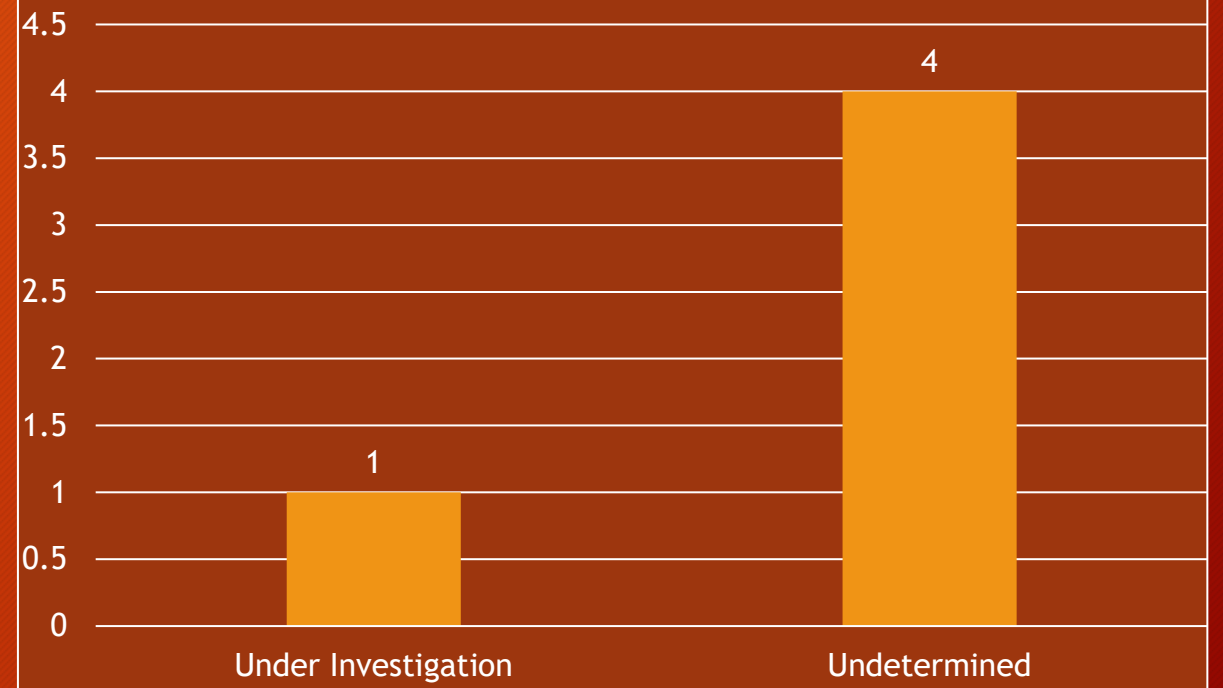

Item First Ignited



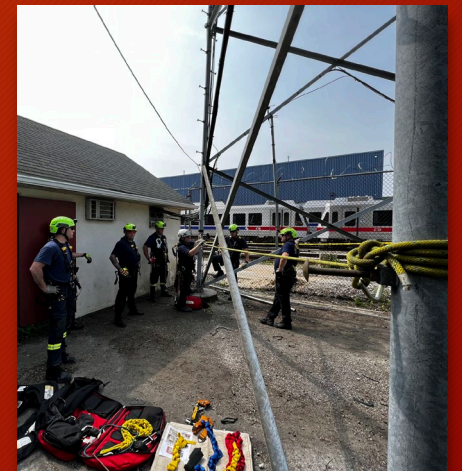
Cause of Ignition

Training Update - S.O.C. Training

- Members of the department's Special Operations Companies (Squad 26 and Truck 37) practiced Tower Rescue evolutions in cooperation with our partners at SEPTA. The training included climbing communication towers, and techniques to rescue the worker's who maintain the area's communication infrastructure. 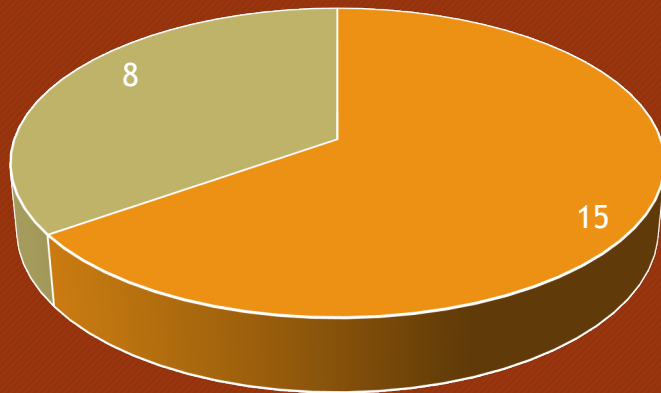

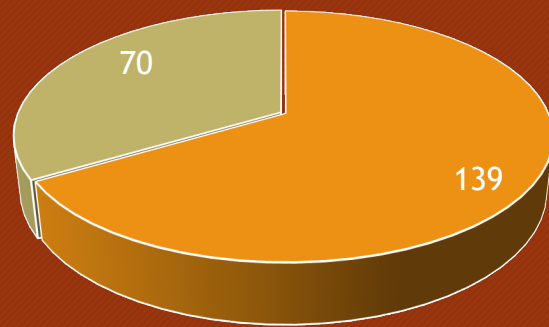

Smoke Alarm Program 2023 Year To Date



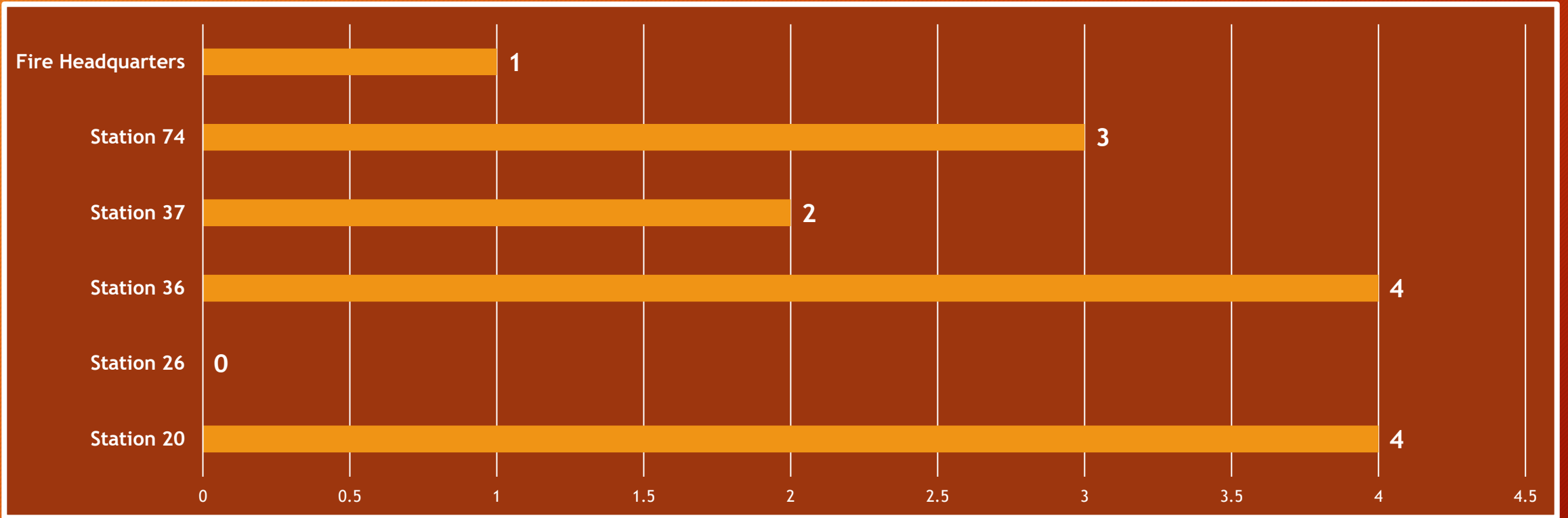

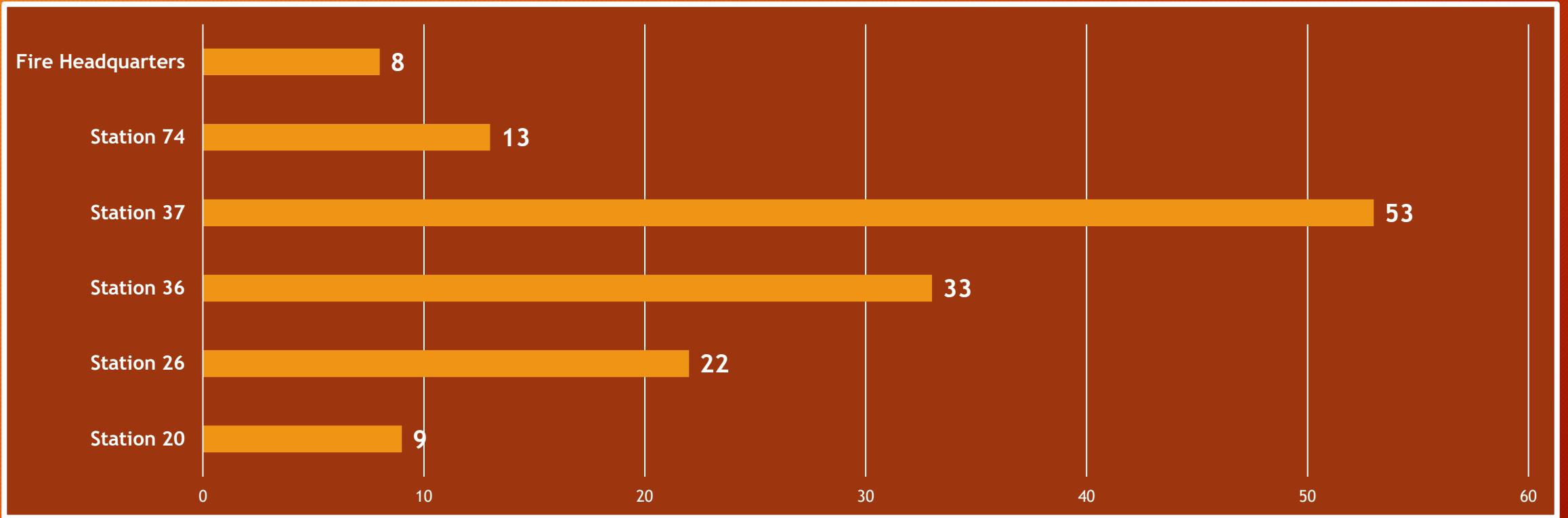

Smoke Alarms Installed by Station May 2023





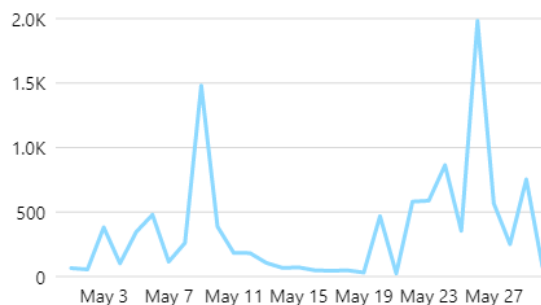
Smoke Alarms Installed by Station Year-to-Date 2023

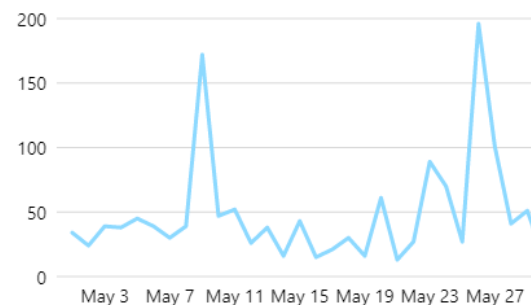
