


NOVEMBER 2022 AVERAGE RESPONSE TIME









INCIDENTS BY SHIFT








NOVEMBER 2022 INCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY




2022 YEAR-TO-DATE INCIDENTS BY HOUR OF THE DAY







Smoke Alarm Installations






