Snow and Ice Safety

snow REMINDER: All property owners are responsible for removing snow from walkways within 24 hours after snow has stopped. Paths must be fully clear of snow and ice and be a minimum of 32" wide. Any snow or ice removed from sidewalks or other areas must not be placed in the gutter, sidewalks, or streets. If there is no front yard, such snow and ice shall be placed on the area adjacent to the curb line.

Beginning January 1, 2024, the annual Business and Mercantile License fee will be set to \$50.
