



APRIL 2023 AVERAGE RESPONSE TIME





INCIDENT RESPONSES BY STATION







STATION CALL PERCENTAGES





INCIDENTS BY SHIFT








UPPER DARBY CAR 3 APRIL 2023 INCIDENTS BY THE HOUR OF THE DAY



The members learn how to handle the hazards of these buildings during emergencies.


Hazardous Materials Operations Refresher

CPR and AED Certification Renewal




Members of the Department have completed their annual CPR/AED certification renewal.




