Part of my administration's mission is to be a world class provider of municipal services to all of our residents, businesses, and visitors. In pursuit of that mission, the Police Department received accreditation by the PA Law Enforcement Accreditation Commission becoming only the 10th department in the County



to be accredited. The Fire Department again certified 100% of its members to the National Professional Qualifications Standards and received recognition from the State Fire Commission while the National Council on Aging unanimously approved the Upper Darby Senior Center for accreditation.

NO plastic bags! Place yard waste in biodegradable paper bags or loose in trash cans.



This Spring the Darby Creek Bridge was installed. The 150' bridge spans Darby Creek from **Gillespie Park** to the Swedish Cabin and is a key connection on the **Darby Creek Trail**. This bridge is funded through the Delaware County Green Ways Grant program and State grants.



Recycling Reminders

A Township recycling container can be obtained for **FREE** by emailing one@upperdarby.org or calling 610-734-7713.

Did you know that **contaminated recycling** costs taxpayers more? Please **do not place recycling in any type of plastic bag** (even the ones that are supposed to be recyclable.) **Do not put** pizza boxes, Styrofoam/packing materials, wood or scrap metal, garden hoses, ceramics, PVC, furniture, shredded paper, or food waste in your recycling bin.

Help keep **yard waste** out of our trash stream by putting leaves, garden residues, shrubbery, and tree trimmings for collection on your RECYCLING day. Tree trimmings should be 4 inches or less in diameter and less than 3 feet long. Only place yard waste in biodegradable paper bags or loose in trash cans; NOT in plastic bags. Yard waste does NOT include grass clippings.
